## From the North

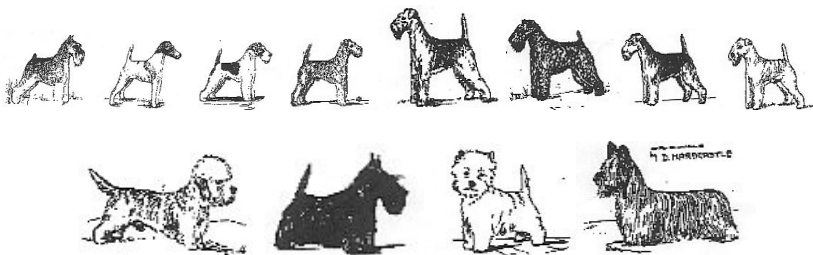

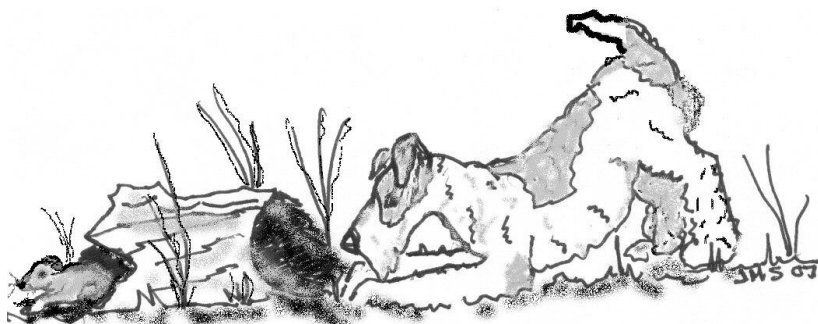
